Genomics

Over the last year the Genomics Clinical Leads' Group has worked with NHS England to make sure all our work is well aligned. Our Genomics Clinical Education Fellow, Professor Kate Tatton-Brown, has been very busy delivering the work commissioned by Health Education England. This includes:

- Finalisation of a generic genomics curriculum that is available for all specialties to adapt for their own needs
- Creation of a framework to facilitate the integration of genomic medicine through the alignment of patient pathways, workforce development and education/training requirements. This has been created as a collaboration between NHS England and NHS Improvement, Health Education England and the Academy.

The Genomics Clinical Leads' Group membership is being widened to ensure that the multi-professional, multi-specialty voice of all healthcare staff is included in changes being made to embed genomic medicine across the NHS. All members will act as genomics champion within their organisations and the group will provide overview/sign off for documents/policies to ensure genomics is implemented across the healthcare landscape in the best way for patients.
